WORDS TO KNOW:

- Trinity:** The mystery that tells us that God is three Divine persons in one God; The Father, Son Jesus and Holy Spirit combined as God. Often it is called the Holy Trinity.
- Mystery:** Something that we cannot understand or comprehend, but we believe because God has told us it is true.
- Incarnate:** God became flesh, that God assumed a human nature and became a man in the form of Jesus Christ, the Son of God.
- Creator:** God is the Creator of all things because He made everything out of nothing.
- Grace:** Grace is God's favor, the free and undeserved help that God gives us to respond to His call, to become children of God and sharers in his eternal life and love.
- To serve:** To be of service to the Community or Church by using our God given talents.
- Guardian Angel:** A special angel given to us by God to help us.

- Q1. Is there only one God?**
There is only one God, but in three equal and distinct Persons, who are the most Holy Trinity.
- Q2. What are the three Persons of the Holy Trinity called?**
The three Persons of the Holy Trinity are called the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.
- Q3. Of the three Persons of the Holy Trinity, was one 'incarnate', that is, made man?**
Yes, the Second Person, God the Son, became 'incarnate', that is; was made man.
- Q4. Why did the Son of God become man?**
The Son of God became man to save us, that is, to redeem us from sin and to regain heaven for us.
