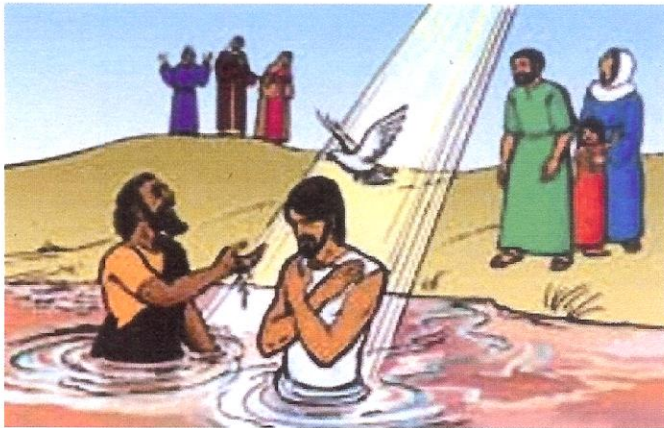


Lesson 8

Getting Ready for the Saviour



Words to Know:

Prophets – Holy persons who prepare the people for the coming of Jesus, the Savior.

Moses – The first Prophet. God gave Moses the Ten Commandments.

Ten Commandments – Laws that God gave to Moses (Refer to Prayer Book to learn the commandments).

John the Baptist – The cousin of Jesus, John was the last of the prophets. He prepared people for the coming of Jesus.

Questions and Answers:

Q1. What are the commandments of God?

A. The Commandments of God are the moral laws which God gave to Moses on Mount Sinai.

Q2. Which commandments tell us how to love God?

A2. Commandments 1, 2 and 3 teach us how to love God.

Q3. Which commandments tell us how to love our neighbors?

A3. Commandments 4-10 teach us how to love our neighbors.

Verse to Learn: Exodus 15:2 - "The Lord is my strength and my might, and he has become my Salvation, this is my God, and I will praise, my father's God, and I will exalt him".

You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.



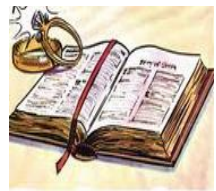
Remember to keep holy the Lord's Day.



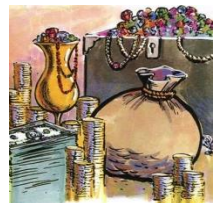
Honour your father and your mother.



You shall not kill.



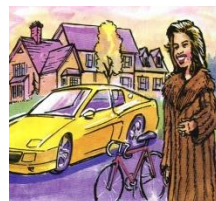
You shall not commit adultery.
