Beatitude 7 - BLESSED ARE THE PEACEMAKERS



Statement – Blessed are the peacemakers,

Reward – For they will be called the Children of God.

“Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called Children of God”.

The priority of promoting peace in human relationships.

We will be happier if we are peacemakers. For this we would need to intervene and make efforts to stop people from fighting and quarreling.

Peacemaking is difficult:

- You require courage to intervene in a fight.
- You will also be misunderstood as a weakling.
- You could possibly get hurt as well.

A peacemaker’s joy however, is greater, since it is hidden and unseen by man.

Lk 5: 27 - 32 – The Call of Levi

“Those who are well have no need for a physician, but those who are sick; I have come to call not the righteous but sinners to repentance.”

*Reflect on how you can try to be a **Peacemaker** :*

*Use your mouth to **Bless**, not **Curse**.*

*Stand up for what is **right**.*

***Reach out** to those who find it difficult to resolve conflicts amongst themselves.*

It could be in your own family, among siblings, or in your friends circle.

*Listen to others with **Humility** and **Patience***

*Find the **Broken things** in your community that breaks your heart, and work toward **Fixing it**.*
