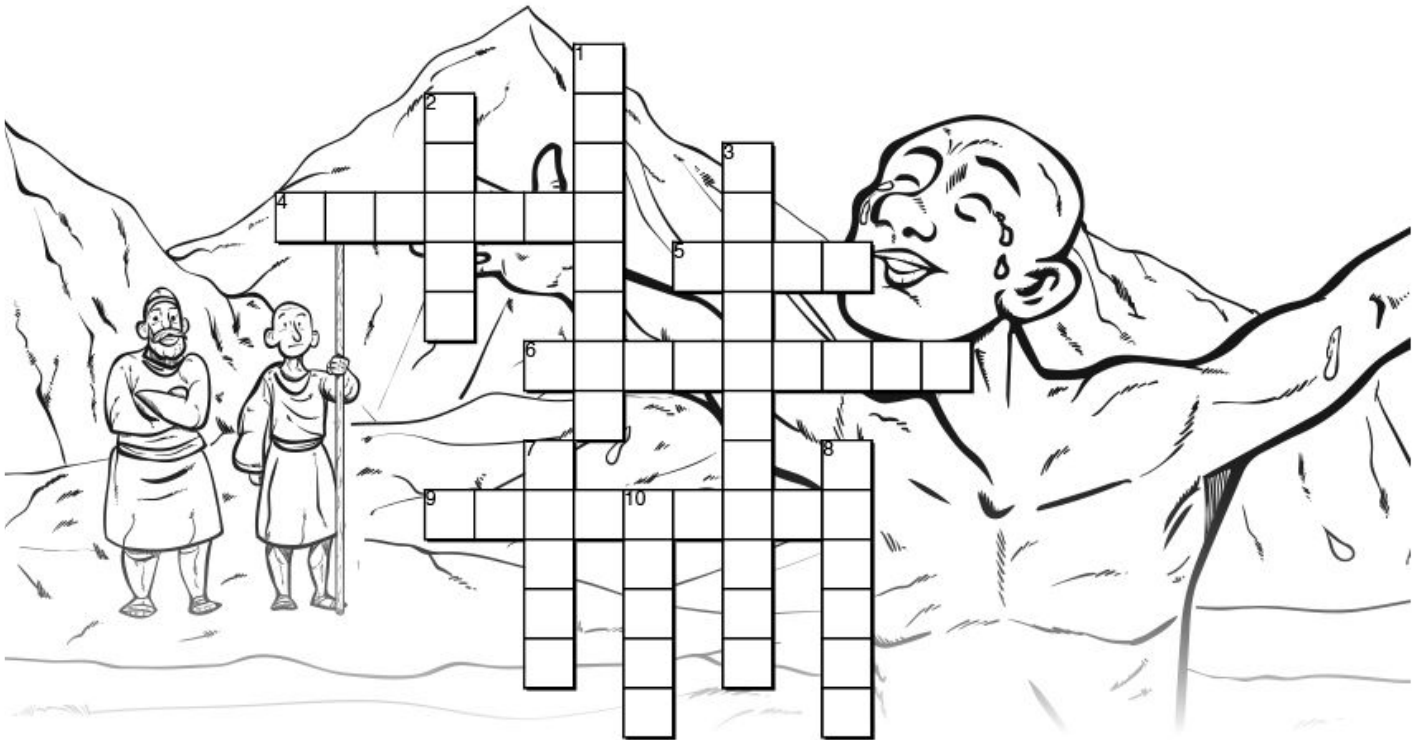
QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS
