1. Name the Sacraments of Initiation?

Answer: Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist.

Where was Jesus Baptized and by whom?

Answer: Jesus was Baptized in the River Jordan by St. John the Baptist.

3. Briefly explain the Sacrament of Baptism?

Answer:

The <u>Sacrament of Baptism</u>, the first of the sacraments of initiation, is an entrance into the Catholic Church. Through baptism, we are cleansed of original sin and receive <u>sanctifying grace</u>, the life of God within our souls. This grace prepares us for the receiving the other sacraments and **helps us to live a holy life**.

4. Briefly explain the Sacrament of Confirmation?

Answer:

The <u>Sacrament of Confirmation</u> is the second Sacraments of Initiation. Sacrament of Confirmation is regarded as the perfection of baptism, and it gives us the grace **to be strong in faith**.

5. Briefly explain the Sacrament of Eucharist?

Answer:

The final sacrament of initiation is the <u>Sacrament of Holy Communion</u>, and Catholics believe that it is the only one of the three that we can (and should) receive repeatedly—even daily, if possible. In Holy Communion, we consume <u>the Body and Blood of Christ</u>, which unites us more closely to Him and gives us the **grace to love Jesus and our neighbor**.
